

Guidelines For Recipient of the Michael J. Perry Memorial Scholarship:

- ✓ The scholarship shall be available to the children of all active members of the following organizations:
 1. Western New York Certified Football Officials Association
 2. Eastern Association of Intercollegiate Football Officials / Empire Chapter
 3. Mid-American Football Officials Association
- ✓ The eligible student will be a graduating senior from a public; private; parochial; charter; or home school.
- ✓ The student will need to demonstrate proficiency/competency in the following areas:
 1. Academics
 2. Extra-Curricular Activities
 3. Community Involvement
 4. Citizenship
 5. Volunteerism
- ✓ The student will need to be attending a two or four-year institution or the equivalent of such. This will include but not be limited to trade/technical schools or schools which lead to a trade under the direction of a journeyman.
- ✓ The amount of the award will be based on the funds available at the time the award is offered. The award may be modified at the discretion of the Committee.
- ✓ The check will be issued by the Community Foundation For Greater Buffalo to the bursar of said university.
- ✓ The successful candidate will need to show proof of acceptance upon notification of the award.
- ✓ The scholarship winner will be determined by the Michael J. Perry Scholarship Foundation Committee until further notice.
- ✓ The application for the scholarship shall be posted by the end of February in each year via web site or E-mail.
- ✓ The applications will be do by published date in March in the year that the student is graduating and a winner will be selected by last day of May in that year.
